This funding will be used to

- Support the reform of Senior School programs to deliver improved student outcomes and transitions to post-school pathways for Yr 11 and 12 students.
- Build the capability of staff in the senior school to deliver student programs through targeted professional development and the provision of physical resources
- Provide staff and funds to support school-based or outside work experience, exploration of post-school options including vocation and leisure and recreation options
- Establish VET VI Assistive Technology CERT 1 course for suitable students
- Align with the AIP Curriculum Priority: Engaged and Challenged Learners in Senior Schooling.

Our initiatives include

- Appointment of a Senior Schooling co-ordinator to work offline one day per fortnight to support the initiatives
- · Investigate joining departmental community of practice in senior schooling
- Investigate options and develop school-based work experience, community-based learning and post-school pathways
- Develop school-based work experience modules with suggested links to the GIL
- Provide additional staff where necessary to support community-based learning and exploring and trialling transition options
- Bring experiences in when students can't go out due to COVID-19 to support their SET-Plan goals of exploring preferences for post-school vocation and leisure options
- Source and complete senior school specific PD to build teacher capacity to deliver programs
- Ensure the SET-Plan process explores post-school pathways through initial senior school curriculum planning and ongoing partnership with parents/cares to have options for end of Year 12
- Investigate implementation of VET VI Assistive Technology Cert I course (TRS to visit Centenary SHS, produce program materials, purchase and maintain materials and devices, etc)
- Ensure students' SET-Planning focuses on exploration of meaningful post-school pathways including community-based programs and supported work options and parents are supported to investigate and make decisions
- Build relationships with post-school providers to improve opportunities to pathway programs for all senior students, including "come and try" days and supporting parents with options to investigate.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Implementing the above initiates to improve student exit outcomes and provide experiences to a variety of postschool options
- Providing staff access to exploring the implementation of the VI Assistive Technology VET Cert I with students
 \$ 5 000
- Funding additional teacher aide time and teacher time to support school-based work experience, community-based learning and exploring post-school options and providers \$27 652
- Giving parents informed choices of post-school pathways and opportunities to investigate them with school support.
